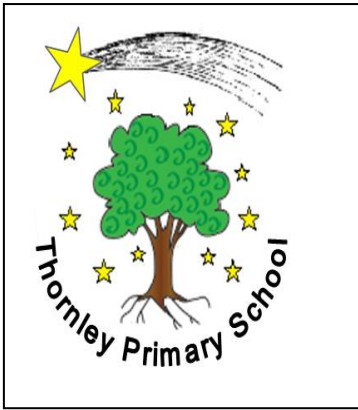


Welcome to Year 4
